# Pitch-A-Palooza Fifty Shades of Pitching

It's back! Do you have an idea for Authentic's next great show? Pitch-A-Palooza is your chance to make it happen. We'll choose a winner, fund a sizzle reel, and pitch it to networks. No idea is too crazy!

### The Rules

- One pitch per person.
- Five minutes to pitch; five additional minutes if you've got video (ten minutes total).
- Everyone **must sign a release** before pitching (see attached).
- You must have written material to leave with us. Anything from a short paragraph to a full treatment of no more than five pages.
- If you are pitching something with specific talent, please have that talent attached or at least verify their interest.
- No children's shows.

### The Process

- Sign up with Lauren Meyer by July 27th.
- The **first round** of pitches begins on August 6th. You will be pitching to Doug, Dana, Colin, and Lauren Meyer, who will narrow the field to a group of finalists.
- Finalists will be notified by email and asked to develop their ideas further for a round two pitch to Tom, Lauren, and Helga.
- The winner will be announced in late **September**.

# The Prize

- Authentic will fund a sizzle reel based on your idea. This includes all hard costs (travel, crew, edit) up to \$10,000. This does not include your time.
- Authentic will have exclusive rights to pitch your idea to networks for one year.
- If the show does not sell at the end of this period, the idea reverts back to you.
- If the show is sold, Authentic will pay you a rights fee of an amount equal to 1.5% of the budget (for example, if the budget is \$200,000 per episode, you get \$3,000 per episode).
- We will try to get you a "created by" credit, but we cannot promise this as a lot of networks don't allow it.
